


Mission: Lifeline System of Care



Iowa Mission: Lifeline Grant

- Grant period: January 2015-January 2018
- \$5.4 Million infused directly into Iowa
 - Rural focus initially
 - * Expanded to offer dollars to urban areas in 2017
- Sustainability Funding
 - \$192,466 in sustainability funding to IDPH
 - * Sub-granted to the 12 EMS service area coalitions in conjunction with Bureau of Emergency and Trauma Services (BETS) All Hazard Emergency Preparedness and Response System Development Grant
 - \$6,000 to Mercy College of Health Sciences to provide 15 training sessions in 2018
- Ongoing regional STEMI meetings
- Ongoing STEMI/Stroke conferences most recently 9/19/2018 in 3 locations across lowal and Nebraska
- * Future advocacy Designation?

109 Mission: Lifeline EMS Grants



Hospital Grants

- * 16 PCI capable and 40 critical access hospitals accepted grants for EKG transmission software
 - Transmission rate of EKGs has almost tripled from beginning of grant period to present day
- Dollars were available to all rural PCI centers during the grant period to collect MI data
- Dollars expanded to urban PCI centers in late 2017
- * Grant helped bring on 20 Iowa hospitals to participate in Mission: Lifeline data collection tool: GWTG CAD

The KEYS to any system of care

- * Identification and notification prior to arrival
- * Activation of downstream care teams
- * Practice and drill
- * Education
- * Plan and discuss as a team before not at the time of the call
- * Have a Plan A, Plan B, Plan C...
- * Guidelines use and educate the next generation
- * Outreach
- * FEEDBACK!


Data Collection and Reporting

Get with the Guidelines Coronary Artery Disease (GWTG-CAD)

- Launched April 2017
- Nearly 800 hospitals participating nationally (as of January 2021)
- * Real-time reporting = regular feedback
- * Only way to participate in Mission: Lifeline
- * 17 PCI centers + 5 CAHs participating in Iowa (as of January 2021)
